PRIMARY SCHOOL

The Nursery and Primary school has finished well. The Kindergarten Top class is graduating to Primary school next year and the Primary Seven will be waiting for their National Examination results



to join Senior school in 2026. Our plans to lease the school didn't work out due to unfavorable terms with the intending team.

Therefore, we will continue to run as Bushfire for now. Its been a challenge for a while



managing with little cost sharing with the community who struggle to play their part. Would appreciate your prayers for staff salaries. We need to keep them motivated with prompt payment.

THE FARM



The farm continues to make some steady progress and producing enough food to sustain us. However, our aim is to step up

production and the sell the surplus to boost our growing school fees budget and other Bushfire running costs.

THE CHURCH



The church started doing a bit more and engaging the community with more on ground programs, We have community children, and youth empowerment programs which helps to know better where they are at, and helping families and young people see opportunities around them.



COMMUNITY OUTREACH



We are equipping our staff with skills to reach out to communities around us with relevant information to help prevent disease in the absence of health facilities in the area. Two government facilities and hardly with enough medicine is a huge challenge to over 40,000 residents. It's a village with no public transport and those who can afford including pregnant mothers use motorcycles. We often use our Bushfire small car for emergencies in the night and day!

DISCIPLESHIP CLASS



We trained 60 students in Discipleship to fulfill the great commission and sent them in the surrounding districts, and three neighboring countries. Will continue this

exercise in 2026 on site and various parts of the country. We had a conference of 600 pastors from the region and we emphasized the same calling of the body of Christ.



CHILDREN CAMP



Please, pray for an upcoming children camp at Bushfire in the second week of December. We expect nearly 400 children to camp in for a week and learn social skills, sports and much fun activities.

UGANDA INSTITUTE OF FAMILY COUNSELING

This term, our team reached 800+ students through several impact school engagements.



We began at Ripples of Hope Nursery and Primary School, where we ministered to 81 teenagers during the teens camp on addictions. It was a blessed and meaningful time, and we were grateful to be part of the camp setup.

At Nakanyonyi Girls Primary School, we reached 300 Primary Seven candidates with a mental-health session that was warmly received. The school has requested more engagements and teacher support.

At YWAM Soroti, our one-week intensive counseling training was highly successful, with both students and staff testifying to the impact of the teachings.

We also visited St. Joseph SSS Nakanyonyi, addressing learners on anger management and later engaging 116 candidate students on fear, anxiety, stress, and relaxation techniques. The administration welcomed more programs next year.
